1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files stored on your device that help websites function and collect information about how they're used. This policy covers cookies and similar technologies (like local storage) used on screenzor.com.

2. Categories of Cookies We Use

Category — Purpose — Examples — Requires Consent?

Strictly necessary — Keep you logged in, remember security settings — Session/auth cookies (via Supabase) — No — essential to the Service

Analytics — Understand how visitors use our site — Google Analytics — Yes, in the EU/UK/South Africa

Advertising — Measure and improve ad performance — Google Ads — Yes, in the EU/UK/South Africa

3. Managing Your Cookie Preferences

When you first visit screenzor.com, a cookie banner lets you accept or reject non-essential cookie categories individually. For visitors in the EU, UK, and South Africa, analytics and advertising cookies remain off and are not set on your device until you affirmatively accept them via the banner — rejecting or ignoring the banner keeps only strictly necessary cookies active. You can change your preference at any time via the "Cookie Settings" link in the site footer.

You can also control cookies through your browser settings, and opt out of Google Analytics specifically using Google's Analytics opt-out browser add-on (<https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>).
